They will be a highly motivated, self-directed and an enthusiastic individuals with excellent interpersonal skills, and will relate well to participants, families, staff, volunteers and community partners.

### **The successful candidates will be primarily responsible for:**

- Providing assistance to the Recreation Therapists, other Activity Care Partners, volunteers and other health care professionals in the delivery and activation programs and services to clients;
- Assists in providing a caring, stimulating environment for participants by following individualized care plans;
- Assists with the day to day routines of Adult Day Service at any site;
- Be prepared to design, lead or take over a program as the situation requires;
- Encouragement of socialization of participants in diversion activities;
- Assists with hygiene & feeding needs when required;
- Sitting, bending, lifting, walking, pushing and pulling in order to provide direct assistance to clients and operate programs;
- Completes daily progress notes as required and discusses new goals/interventions with team members to be added to care plans;
- Any other related duties as assigned by the Program Manager or designate;
- Candidate must be willing to cover multiple sites (any of the Leeds and Grenville Adult Day Services sites).

### **Qualifications:**

- Minimum PSW (Personal Support Worker) certificate from an accredited program required.
- Certificate in Gerontology, Activation, Recreation programs considerate an asset.
- Knowledge of Alzheimer's disease, related dementia, frail elderly challenges and the effect on the client and their family.
- Experience in caring for the cognitively impaired.
- Good oral and written communication skills.
- Well-developed interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work independently, and as part of a team.
- Required to have a reliable vehicle, a valid drivers' license, clear drivers record, and appropriate auto insurance.
- Satisfactory Criminal Record Check, and Vulnerable Sector Screening.
- A current CPR certificate, Level C.
- Required to provide coverage for all areas.
