



BROKERED FOOT CARE NURSES NEEDED

Senior Support Services - CPHC is a registered charitable organization dedicated to improving the lives of seniors and their families by providing community support services.

CPHC invites applications for brokered foot care nurses (RPN). Foot care nurses are brokered by CPHC, and are not employees of CPHC.

The successful foot care nurses (RPN) will provide foot care service to clients at multi monthly clinics. These clinics are currently running at full capacity during office hours. Nurses are needed for **Brockville**. Successful candidates will have use of two autoclaves located on site (*bonus – may use autoclave for their personal, non-CPHC clients) or candidate must have access to a Public Health Ontario approved autoclave and reprocessing space.

In response to COVID—19 CPHC has prepared guidelines specific to the Foot Care program to ensure our clients, volunteers and brokered nurses stay safe during this time. Brokered foot care nurses will be provided with the full PPE during this time.

Responsibilities

- Monitor and deliver foot care to clients in a clinic setting as per the nursing care plan and in accordance with all required internal and external professional practice standards;
- Provide high quality services to clients;
- Follow reprocessing guidelines and proper procedures;
- Understand and implement infection prevention practices while specifically adhering to CPHC standards, policies and procedures;
- Ensure proper set up and cleanliness.

Qualifications

- Graduation from an accredited Registered Practical Nursing Program;
- Current registration with the provincial licensing body is required;
- Advanced Footcare Certification is required;
- Previous experience with Geriatric and Diabetic populations considered an asset;
- Experience working with the elderly and with cognitively impaired individuals;
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills;
- Positive interpersonal skills;
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team;
- Able to perform and prioritize multiple functions and tasks;
- Satisfactory Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Screening;
- Ability to travel;
- Access to a reliable vehicle.
